Students in the Honors Program for the School of Arts must enroll in Accelerated, Honors, or AP/ Dual Enrollment Courses when available. DS students will complete a minimum of four AP courses and maintain a minimum of a 3.3 academic GPA by the end of 7<sup>th</sup> Semester. (Honors Graduation Distinction).
